BALLET FEVER reserved early, rallied along the rail to take over entering the stretch and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to last over RED STAG. The latter, tracked the pace, was outmoved by the winner into the stretch, then responded to pressure and was gaining on that rival again at the finish. UNTUTTTABLE AFFAIR rated off the pace, steadied in traffic on the first turn, raced four wide on the far turn and closed to gain the show. FAIR WEATHER STAN set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch, then tired. TUXEDO TAKEOUT failed to menace after being outrun early. MAJICAL WAY allowed to settle, raced five wide on the far turn and had no response when asked. CARSON'S CONCERTO chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered. TOUR D'LIGHT chased the pace into the far turn, then faded.
