JACKSON BEND reserved after bobbling at the start, altered course outside a wall of horses at the top of the stretch for racing room, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole, then held SANGAREE safe. The latter, off slowly, was outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and closed well to be up for the place. COOL BLUE RED HOT allowed to settle, rallied five wide around the turn to reach near even terms for command in the stretch, then gave way. SOARING EMPIRE rated off the pace, rallied four to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch, maintained that advantage to the sixteenth pole and weakened. DECISIVE MOMENT pressed the pace outside WILL'S WILDCAT, gained a brief lead on the turn, then tired in the drive. SKY VENTURE stalked the pace to midway of the turn, then faltered. SUCCESSFUL MISSION was caught in tight soon after the start, chased the pace three wide, made a run to reach the leaders at the quarter pole, then faded. WILL'S WILDCAT showed speed along the rail to midway of the turn, then had nothing left.
