TAKE ME THERE bumped with DREAM FLEET at the start, stalked the pace, moved to take over entering the stretch, then drew away under pressure. DREAM FLEET outrun after lunging and bumping with TAKE ME THERE at the start, raced four wide on the far turn and closed to be up for the place. CALLTER rated off the pace, was caught in traffic leaving the far turn, angled out for racing room and was just edged for the place gaining the show. JANE'S HALO off slowly, tracked the pace four wide around the far turn and gave way. EXIST well placed while saving ground, eased out and made a run to loom a threat approaching the eighth pole, then tired. RUNTHERAPIDS chased the pace, made a run at the leaders three wide on the far turn, then faltered in the drive. LAKESHORE was not a factor. PAT SPEEDY set the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch and faded.
