Footnotes

HARLINGTON stalked the pace three wide, moved to take over on the far turn and drew clear under pressure. CRIMINAL MIND unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to prove second best while unable to stay with the winner. GLOBAL TRADER tracked the leaders off the rail into the stretch, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones while holding the show. SIR JACKIE outrun early, passed tired rivals in the drive. SHORTY KNUDTSON raced in striking position into the far turn and gave way. PESCADITO rated off the pace, tired in the drive. MONOPOLY PRICING took a bad step on the first turn and was checked to recover his footing, advanced along the outside down the backstretch to reach contention entering the far turn, then faltered. TEPEXPAN vied for the lead outside INDY MOON to midway of the far turn, then had nothing left for the drive. INDY MOON vied for the lead along the inside to midway of the far turn and faded. BOLD LEADERSHIP well placed after breaking slowly, raced four wide on the far turn and stopped. RUBIALEDO saved ground, was done early and eased in the stretch run. MUSHA CAY unhurried early, pulled up on the far turn and was vanned off.
