Footnotes

ALMA D'ORO pressed the pace, moved to take over from NO DETOUR soon after entering the turn, then drew away through the stretch under a hand ride. DUBINSKY rank under restraint while chasing the early pace, eased out to make a run at ALMA D'ORO around the turn but was no match for that rival in the stretch while clearly best of the others. WEBCAST tracked the leaders around the turn and tired. UNBRIDLED CARDINAL outrun after breaking poorly, was never a threat. PASS CODE stumbled soon after the start and was never a factor. NO DETOUR stumbled at the start, set the pace under pressure along the inside into the turn, then faltered. SATORIUS tracked the leaders three wide around the turn and faded. EDGE APPEAL showed little after stumbling at the start. ANKIMO was done early and eased in the final eighth.
