CASANOVA STAR steadied along on the first turn, rallied into the stretch to gain command, drew clear, then was all out to hold off ECTON PARK. The latter, up close early, eased back down the backstretch, split rivals in early stretch and closed fast. BOOKMOBILE, reserved early, circled four wide on the far turn to get the lead, then tired in the drive. CAYMAN CAT, reserved off the pace, made a bid four wide on the far turn and faltered. RIDE 'EM RAGS set the pace under pressure along the rail and faded. BE VALIANT, wide around the first turn, chased the pace and gave way. COLD EXPRESS, wide around the first turn, forced the pace into the far turn and faded. SAND DOLLAR SHEIKH showed little. JUST SIGN showed early speed, tired racing into the far turn, then bolted and was pulled up.
