MONARCH LANE chased the pace four wide, rallied to take over leaving the turn and drew away under urging. NORTHERN GENT unhurried after breaking slowly, rallied to be up for the place while no threat to the winner. SPANISH MISSION set the pace off the rail, was steady to avoid coming out into BRITISH ATTITUDE and MONARCH LANE on the turn, then drifted out badly through the stretch and gave way. SILVER WHISTLE allowed to settle, saved ground and passed tired rivals. PARKER VALLEY outrun early, improved his position in the drive. BRITISH ATTITUDE prompted the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and tired. EXCEPTIONAL APPEAL off slowly, was not a factor. RATIONALEXUBERANCE chased the pace to midway of the turn and faltered. BACHELOR'S GULCH was through after a half mile. SAINT THADDEUS well placed early, faded. COLONIAL SILVER off slowly, raced three wide on the turn and stopped. BLADES OF SILVER was done early.
