MASTER COMMAND set the pace outside PREMIUM TAP, moved to the inside on the far turn when that rival dropped back, opened a clear lead in the stretch, then was fully extended to hold PREMIUM TAP safe. The latter, raced with the pace along the rail, was outmoved on the far turn, then eased out for the drive and closed to prove second best while unable to get to the winner. A. J. MELINI stalked the pace three wide, was steadied to avoid running up on MARAQUERO leaving the far turn, then closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. INDY STORM unhurried early, saved ground and improved his position without threatening. LEADING THE PARADE raced three wide and failed to menace. MARAQUERO prompted the pace outside MASTER COMMAND to nearing the stretch, then tired. TALENTED PRINCE turned in a dull effort. COME CLOSE tracked the pace into the far turn and faltered.
