FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Saturday, January 2, 2010, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$1,000 additional to start, with \$100,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$60,000, \$20,000 to second, \$10,000 to third, \$5,000 to fourth, \$3,000 to fifth and \$2,000 to sixth. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry at a fee of \$4,000, which includes entry and starting fees. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; a sweepstakes at a mile or over, 4 lbs., two races other than maiden or claiming 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with Also Eligibles. If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box preference will be given to graded stakes winners then highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 84 feet).

Footnotes

NORDIC TRUCE outrun after being steadied in the early going, angled out for racing room in the stretch and closed with a late rush to be up in time. BIM BAM chased the pace along the inside, eased out on the far turn and rallied to take over at the top of the stretch, repulsed a bid from CALL SHOT inside the eighth pole, then just failed to last. CALL SHOT rated off the pace, rallied along the rail to reach even terms for command inside the eighth pole, then weakened. LUCAS BRADY unhurried early, advanced to reach contention in the stretch and finished willingly. GUYS REWARD allowed to settle, made a run to reach contention in the stretch but didn't do enough late. CITY TROOPER well placed while saving ground, made a run to loom a threat in the stretch but couldn't sustain his bid. RAGING WIT reserved off the pace, made a run three wide around the far turn to reach near even terms for command in the stretch, then tired. MR. VEGAS off slowly, trailed into the far turn, swung out for the drive and gained ground late. OUR CHAMPION raced three wide and had no response when asked. BERNIE THE MAESTRO set the pace along the inside to the top of the stretch, then faltered. HELLEN'S CHOICE chased the pace into the far turn and faded.
