Footnotes

DEMI TASSE took command by slight margin in opening quarter, began to steadily widen margin in backstretch and continued clear in late drive. NORWAY STAR tracked the pacesetters in early stages, urged up along inside going into turn, drifted in slightly at eighth pole and finished clearly second best. SHERRY ANGEL stalked the pace in opening stages, raced between rivals in the turn, angled over to rail in stretch and finished evenly. DOT THOSE EYES pressed pace in opening quarter, continued to track the pace in backstretch, made a bid between rivals in the turn and lacked late kick in drive to make impact. CLASSIC POINT raced five wide at the top of the lane and continued a even bid to the wire. FRENCH CONCORDE raced near the back of the pack in backstretch and failed to be a threat in the stretch. BACK BAYOU raced up close to lead in opening quarter and had nothing left after a half mile.
