ANOTHER IVORY reserved early, rallied four wide around the far turn, moved to take over at the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. MAN I LOVE CLARE unhurried early, saved ground into the stretch, angled outside the leaders and was gaining on the winner at the finish. BAZARGAN sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace to midstretch and weakened. SALITROSA outrun early, passed tired rivals along the outside in the drive. CALEDON COLLEEN raced in striking while saving ground into the stretch, then lacked a late response. MISS DIXIE DREAM chased the pace off the rail into the stretch and tired. COOL ARIA was outrun. TACTICAL PUNCH rated off the pace after being steadied in the early going, made a run three wide on the far turn to loom a threat, then faltered. CRY A NOTE chased the pace to nearing the far turn and faded.
