## **Footnotes**

JULES BEST reserved after being bumped at the start, saved ground, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to gain the lead at the sixteenth pole and won going away. KATHERN'S CAT stalked the pace, eased outside the leaders and made a run duel for the outside LOOKING FOR LOOT in the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner late while holding the place. LOOKING FOR LOOT stalked the pace along the inside, eased out and split rivals to duel for the lead but couldn't match strides with the winner late while being edged for the place. LOVE IS THE ANSWER unhurried early, closed with a mild response. MIAMI PRINCESS outrun early, rallied to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out. SHINE PLEASE allowed to settle, was saving ground when steadied looking for room on the far turn, slipped through along the rail and rallied to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't sustain her bid. ACTSTATIC rated off the pace, moved into contention four wide on the far turn, then tired in the drive. HONORING CAROLYN was bumped into JULES BEST at the start, set along the rail to midstretch, then gave way. LOOKSTOOGOOD reserved off the pace, faltered leaving the far turn. MADISON DOLLIE bumped HONORING CAROLYN at the start, prompted the pace outside that rival to nearing the stretch, then faded. POSH PARTY tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and stopped. (The rail on the turf course was set at 48 feet).
