INTROVERT vied for the lead off the rail, responded when challenged by CARTIER LADY on the turn, then drew clear under urging. AMERICAN PLACED reserved off the pace, rallied to reach the attending position in the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid and just saved the place. DATTTTS APPEALING allowed to settle, raced four wide around the turn and closed with a mild response to just miss the place. A PERFECT SQUEEZE outrun early, raced three wide around the turn and passed tired rivals. CARTIER LADY chased the pace three wide, made a run at the winner around the turn and into the stretch, then tired. SWEET HARP failed to menace. PEDROIA off slowly, was no factor while racing four wide. LADY BLUEGRASS chased the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. PLATINUM FUTURES vied for the lead into the turn, then had nothing left. DO IT BABY tracked the pace three wide to midway of the turn and faded.
