Footnotes

RESPONSIVE EYE was unhurried in opening stages and saved ground tucked along the rail going into first turn, steadily advanced position along the rail in the backstretch, asked for response nearing the far turn, angled out three wide, inched up to lead three deep at top of the stretch, took command and drew clear. UNPRECEDENTED broke sharp and took lead going into the far turn, continued to dictate the pace along the rail in the backstretch, challenged by rivals heading into the turn, vied along the rail in the uppers stretch and could not match strides nearing middle of the lane. DUBAI LAD raced behind the pacesetter in opening stages, continued to track the lead in the backstretch, asked to pick up pace nearing far turn, vied between rivals at the top of the lane and slightly weakened in late drive. ACT OF WAR (IRE) tracked the pace in early stages, given cue heading into far turn, began to gain position and slightly settled back in upper stretch, continued evenly to the wire. DRAGON TAIL stalked the pace along the rail in early stages, saved ground along the inside heading for home, lost whip near the eighth pole and finished evenly in the drive. MASTER OF MARKETS settled in and stalked the pace in early stages, urged to pick up pace heading into far turn and lacked a kick in the drive. MAR BRAVO raced four wide going into the first turn, continued settled along the outside in the backstretch, made a outside bid going into turn and failed to rally in stretch. BEST OF hit the side of the gate at the start, rushed up toward the lead, was caught five wide into first turn and slightly weakened in middle of the backstretch. SILVER SKATES settled in early stages and raced

three off the inside, continued reserved near the back of rivals and failed to be a threat in the stretch. LITTLE BRIT stalked between rivals in the backstretch and began to fade at the top of the lane. ROCKITUDE dropped back to last in the backstretch and was pulled up in the stretch.
