**Footnotes**

HE'S A CYCLONE raced just off the leader and pressed the early pace, steadily edged up to the pacesetter nearing the far turn, matched strides along outside of rival in the far turn, took command by a slight margin at the top of the lane, drifted out slightly under left handed urging at sixteenth pole and continued on under brisk encouragement. SEEKINGTHEDIAMOND hit the gate at the start, pulled in opening stages, continued to track the pace in the backstretch, made a three wide bid going into the turn, was bumped by foe in the turn, briefly lost momentum and continued a steady bid in the late stretch. BERNIE'S BEST stalked the pace in opening stages, urged up along rail in the backstretch, asked to pick up pace, shifted out slightly, was bumped hard repeatedly in the turn, lost momentum briefly and kept on gamely in the drive. TURKISH took command in opening stages and set the pace along the rail, challenged by HE'S A CYCLONE nearing the far turn, briefly matched strides along inside, raced erratically in the turn, steadied sharply and came up empty in the drive. ARTIE'S JASPER settled in early stages and stalked the pace along the rail, asked to pick up the pace nearing the far turn, angled out, was carried out further by foe in the turn and finished evenly four wide in the drive. AL AQSA was forwardly placed in opening quarter, continued to track the pace in early stages and began to weaken heading into the far turn. LUDICROUS SPEED stalked the pace along the outside of a rival in the early going, asked for response nearing the far turn and lacked response in the drive. PACK LEADER hesitated slightly at the start, urged up and stalked leaders in early stages, began to weaken after a half mile and had nothing left in the lane.
