**Footnotes**

SUGAR SWIRL was caught in tight at the start, moved up to press the pace three wide, gained the lead approaching the quarter pole and opened a clear advantage, then was fully extended to last over PROSPECT OF LOVE. The latter, unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. SHARI'S GOLD SOLE tracked the pace, eased out for the drive and closed with a mild response for the show. CAT CAN DO outrun after breaking slowly, swung wide for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. ASHLEE THE GREAT tracked the pace three wide around the turn and weakened. ROYAL FUDGE tracked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch, then gave way. FOR GILLIAN vied for the lead between horses to the top of the stretch, then tired. ROYAL PLEASURE vied for the lead along the inside to nearing the stretch, then faltered. NANCY CREEK up close early, steadied entering the turn and faded. PLEASANT LAUGHTER raced four wide and was done early.
