Footnotes

HIGHLAND SARA broke well and raced up to track the top two leaders, asked to pick up the pace nearing the far turn, shifted out three wide into the lane, took command near the eighth pole and drew clear. TIME COUNTS took command by a slight margin at the start, continued to set the pace near the inside, challenged by CRIOLLA LINDA nearing the far turn, lost the lead along the rail, shifted out at eighth pole, drifted out slightly under left handed pressure and dug back in for place. CRIOLLA LINDA raced right behind the pacesetter in early stages, made a bid for leader going into far turn, took command briefly at the top of the lane, raced between rivals in upper stretch and slightly weakened in the late drive. LOVE NUMBERS was forced to steady after the start, stalked the pace along the inside, given cue nearing the far turn, swung out four wide and flattened out in the drive. FOXY AFFAIR was settled along the inside in early stages, slightly gained position in the backstretch, angled out nearing the far turn and lacked late kick in the drive. GREAT MARTINI stalked the pace along the rail in the backstretch, floated out five to six wide into the turn and failed to rally in the stretch. COUNTESS ALBIE made a brief bid for the lead after the start, steadily weakened after and was eased up in the stretch.
