STOPSHOPPINGMARIA rushed up to the lead in opening stages, vied along the outside of MOSAICIST in the backstretch, continued to battle with rival into the lane, shook free at the eighth pole and continued clear to the wire. MOSAICIST (IRE) up close to the lead in opening stages, dueled along the inside of SHOPSHOPPINGMARIA in the backstretch, continued to vie with rival into the stretch, could not match strides midstretch and finished a clear second. MY JOPIA was reserved in early stages and raced in the back of rivals, asked to pick up the pace nearing the far turn, swung out five wide at the top of the lane and gained ground in the stretch. REVENUE stalked the pace in the backstretch, saved ground racing along the inside in the turn, raced in tight and steadied near the eighth pole and kept on late. READY TO UNLEASH stalked the pace three off the inside in the backstretch, continued a steady bid into the lane and lacked final kick in the drive. WAR PROSPECTOR tracked the top two leaders in early stages and slightly weakened after a half mile. OBRIGETA tracked the top two leaders in the backstretch, continued within contention along the rail in the far turn, gave way approaching the eighth pole, bled.
