Footnotes

ULLAPOOL broke sharply to gain the advantage, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the rail racing into the bend, edged away to a clear advantage racing into upper stretch, then drifted out in the closing stages to turn back a challenge from MY PAL CHRISY in the final sixteenth to prevail under firm encouragement. The latter, reserved while racing in close quarters along the inside early tracking off the leaders, swung out four wide racing into upper stretch while producing a steady response to close the gap, moved to challenge the leader leaving midstretch but lost some momentum when being carried out late. SALAMERA was urged along to maintain a contending position tracking off the first flight along the inside racing into the bend, switched outside foes nearing upper stretch to race three wide in the lane but continued willingly to the end to earn a share. R FREE ROLL threw her head at the start losing position to the field, was switched outside foes while being prompted to gain contention four deep racing to the bend, shifted inwards a bit racing into the turn while pursuing the pacesetter three deep but emptied out racing into upper stretch. CLASSIC POINT was urged along three deep to maintain terms with the first flight racing through the backstretch, steadied out of close quarters racing into the turn and never regained contention. LADYFROMHAVANA, in touch with the eventual winner in the opening stages prompting that foe's pace, continued between foes in pursuit of the leader racing into the turn and gave way after a half.
