**Footnotes**

STAR CHANNEL secured a forward placing along the rail in the opening stages tracking just off the leaders under light rating, steadily moved to challenge while switching out three deep racing into upper stretch, was bumped entering the lane by OLD TIME HOCKEY, shifted inwards while continuing to dispute the issue outside that foe and exchanged repeated contact to the end while just edging that rival under pressure. OLD TIME HOCKEY gained a forward placing stalking just off a rival under light rating racing into the backstretch, moved to gain the advantage on the far turn while remaining a bit off the rail, shifted out a bit bumping STAR CHANNEL entering upper stretch, continued to resist that rival while racing in close quarters near the rail in the closing stages and exchanged contact with the winner again nearing the wire while just failing to contain that foe. BAD DEBT, bumped by BIM BAM, then squeezed between foes at the break, settled off the second flight outside foes early, was urged to advance while being fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and continued willingly to the end to close the gap. BLAMESHIFTER settled into stride near the inside in the opening five furlongs, swung six wide racing into upper and continued willingly in that path to gain position to the end. SPRING UP, reserved along the inside in the opening half, gained some position between foes nearing upper stretch, angled out racing through the stretch while being prompted to advance between foes but lacked the needed final kick. HOBBS, pulling a bit between foes in the opening stages, switched outside foes racing into the backstretch to track the leaders in second flight, lodged a brief three wide bid racing between foes on the far turn but soon proved empty. TIZ GIANNI rated along the inside tracking off the second flight, saved ground on the far turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. RACING APTITUDE moved to the fore while angling to the rail racing to the first turn,

dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend and emptied out once headed racing into upper stretch. BIM BAM broke inwards bumping BAD DEBT, was settled outside foes early and never gained contention. TUNE ME IN, bumped by BAD DEBT at the start, bobbled, was quickly righted to gain a contending position just off the first flight, shifted three wide nearing the far turn briefly prompting the leaders, was then eased racing into upper stretch, briefly ran loose following the race but was collected by the outrider and walked off the course under his own power. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF OLD TIME HOCKEY LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER WHILE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED A CONCURRENT INQUIRY BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
