Footnotes

RIBO BOBO, never far back, stalked the pacesetter under light reserve racing through the backstretch, continued with a steady bid to challenge for command under some mild prompting racing into upper stretch, gained a clear advantage under some right handed pressure in the closing stages and was taken in hand nearing the wire. HAPPY MY WAY broke slowly, was urged to gain a contending position just off the first flight in the opening quarter, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch while being prompted to advance, couldn't match terms with the winner but continued with interest to gain the place honors late. STAR HARBOUR sprinted to the lead while angling inside in the opening furlong, set the pace on a diminishing margin racing into upper stretch and weakened leaving the furlong marker. BEAR TOUGH TIGER shied inwards at the start crowding BLACK DIAMOND CAT, was righted to track the leaders from just out of striking distance off the inside, angled to the inside racing into upper stretch and finished evenly in late stages. GRANDE SHORES settled into stride along the inside early and continued evenly into the stretch. BLACK DIAMOND CAT, held up avoiding close quarters just after the break, never gained contention. CLOSE IT OUT, caught seven wide early, proved no factor. FORT LOUDON broke slowly and never gained contention. APRIORITY raced six deep between foes in the opening stages but soon retreated.
