BUY OUT TIME set the early pace along the inside, relinquished the lead along the backstretch, raced up close while saving ground on the turn, battled heads apart into midstretch, shook off SPIN CONTROL in deep stretch then was all out to hold off FOREVER NOW in the final strides. FOREVER NOW broke slowly, raced wide along the backstretch, angled to the inside on the far turn, steadied along the rail then dropped back while rallying at the quarter pole, altered course to the outside entering the stretch then closed steadily but could not get up. SPIN CONTROL settled just off the early pace, closed the gap while four wide on the turn, surged to the front in upper stretch, battled into deep stretch then yielded late. FOOTLIGHTS was reserved for five furlongs while racing wide, circled five wide leaving the turn then closed late in the middle of the track. PLEDGE OF PEACE failed to threaten while racing wide. GYPSY DOT moved up four wide to take the lead along the backstretch, continued on the front to the turn then tired in the stretch. SLEW CITY DANCER broke outward at the start, failed to mount a serious rally. MEZMER EYES was shuffled back slightly entering the backstretch, was finished after going five furlongs. SPRING MINT bumped at the start, rushed up from outside, gave way after a half and was eased late
