NATHAN RIDGE was settled while racing five wide on the backstretch, rallied on the turn while staying out five wide then was in a long sustained drive in the stretch and proved best in the end. GRAND STAGE was unhurried early while inside on the backstretch and turn, swung out to be three wide in upper stretch then was gaining ground willingly to finished well in the end but came up a tad short. DANCE FLOOR MANIAC set a pressured pace while racing two wide on the backstretch and turn, was in a long sustained drive and gamely dug in throughout the stretch but tired in late stretch. CHAYSEN' ALEX was hustled along the inside to move up and pressed the pace going into the turn, gained a slim lead in the middle of the turn, dug in gamely in the stretch drive but weakened in late stretch. LITTLE DOVEFEATHER was unhurried early while being settled, raced four wide on the turn and failed to menace throughout. BOURBON TRAIL pressed the pace while racing three wide on the turn, was hard used on the turn to stay in contention then faltered in the stretch. KAFWAIN WEDGEHEART pressed the early pace while racing four wide on the backstretch, was used up then stopped badly and was being eased up in deep stretch.
