Footnotes

ANNAWON reserved racing along the rail, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole, then was all out to last over LEIPZIG. The latter, unhurried after

breaking slowly, saved ground, was blocked in behind ANNAWON from the top of the stretch to deep stretch, eased outside that rival and rallied to just miss. BWANA BRAVE allowed to settle, swung out for the stretch run and closed well to just miss catching the top ones. EAST INDIES set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run, responded when headed nearing the eighth pole, then gave way grudgingly late. BIG TOP rated off the pace, rallied three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch but didn't do enough late. DAX outrun early, closed with a belated rally. FOURSEVENTEEN tracked the pace four wide, rallied to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole, then was tiring when checked from inside BWANA BRAVE late. BARTH'S APPROVAL failed to menace. GO JOE GO chased the pace, made a run to reach near even terms for command in midstretch, then weakened. GARRYOWEN stalked the pace three wide to the top of the stretch and faltered. RUHTRO was not a factor. BAKERS WOODS was outrun. THE RIDER OF FOURSEVENTEEN LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF BWANA BRAVE FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH. THE CLAIM OF FOUL WAS NOT ALLOWED.
