**Footnotes**

DON'S PEACH chased CALIFORNIA QUICK off the rail, rallied to catch that rival at the top of the stretch and opened a clear lead, then maintained her advantage to the wire under pressure. CALIFORNIA QUICK showed speed while angling over to the inside, made the pace to the top of the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. OUR PLUM PUTTING reserved off the pace, passed tired rivals for the show. COOL VIXEN saved ground and failed to menace. FULL MOON FROLIC chased the pace three wide around the turn and tired. STARSHIP SPIRIT saved ground and faltered. BEACH LIGHTNING tracked the pace three wide into the turn and faded. SIXTY ACRES was no factor after being caught in tight at the start. THE RIGHT BUTTON was done early. MAGICPAGE was outrun. SOUTHSIDE LADY showed little. TRUE EXPECTATIONS steadied soon after the start and trailed.
