MISS SQUEAL stalked the pace in early stages, made a bid for leader nearing the far turn, shifted out four wide into the lane, angled back in slightly, took command, drifted out late stretch and held clear. HILLABY took command in opening stages, continued to dictate the pace in the backstretch, challenged by rivals heading into the far turn, could not match strides midstretch and finished clear second. NATIVE BOMBSHELL tracked the pace setters in early stages, asked to pick up the pace approaching the quarter pole, began to inch up to the lead in the turn and failed to sustain bid in the upper drive. LEMONSrgOODONGRASS unhurried early and stalked the pacesetters two wide in the backstretch, began to pick up the pace nearing the far turn and improved position in the stretch. WHO'S MARY'S DADDY took lead in opening quarter, settled back slightly and raced just off the pacesetter, began to weaken after a half mile and lacked response in the drive. SPARKLING SOUL raced in the back of rivals in early stages, continued reserved heading into the far turn and failed to rally in the stretch. SEASONSOFtheHEART raced behind the top two leaders in opening quarter and began to weaken after a half mile. SHENTON PARK stalked the pace in early stages, made a bid and gained position nearing the far turn and faded in the upper stretch.
