REGALO MIA raced near the inside going into the first turn, settled in and stalked the front runners, continued patiently heading near the far turn, given her cue nearing the far turn, swung out four wide into the turn, steadily edged up along the outside of leaders in the lane, dug in late and kicked clear. HOOH WHY pulled slightly in opening stages, raced just off the leader and continued to press the pace, inched up to the lead heading into the turn, vied along the outside of ROMACACA in the upper stretch, shook free momentarily but could not hold off REGALO MIA in late strides. ROMACACA took command in opening stages, continued to set the pace along the rail by a slight margin over foes, was challenged by rivals nearing the far turn, vied along the inside of HOOH WHY into the lane and could not match strides in late drive. MILLENNIA stalked the pace along the inside in early stages, began to advance position along the rail nearing the far turn, urged along in the uppers stretch and lacked a late kick to make an impact. CALLMETHESQUEEZE tracked the pacesetters in the early going, asked to pick up pace nearing the far turn, edged up to the lead but could not sustain bid into the lane. REFINING raced just off the leader in the opening quarter, continued to track the pace and began to falter after a half mile.
