Footnotes

COLCON was unhurried for a half, rapidly gained while four wide on the turn, closed the gap to challenge a sixteenth out then prevailed in a hard drive. LOVERS KNOT (GB) raced well back for six furlongs, circled five wide rallying into the stretch then closed steadily but could not get up. TAMPICO raced well back to the turn then rallied belatedly to gain a share. WINFAMA took the lead soon after the start, opened a clear advantage along the backstretch, extended her advantage in upper stretch then yielded in the final seventy yards. POOPSIE checked at the start, was outrun for five furlongs, rallied between horses on the turn then improved her position in the lane. PLEASANT TEMPER lodged a bid between horses while three wide on the turn and flattened out. ZINFANDOLL raced just off the pace under a snug hold along the backstretch, moved between horses on the turn and tired in the drive. DEER BERRY forced the pace for seven furlongs and gave way. DANCE CLEAR (IRE) steadied on the far turn, never reached contention. NEEDHAM STAR saved ground and tired.
