QUEEN OF NORWAY reserved after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to gain command inside the eighth pole and edged away under steady urging. CIRCLE OF GOLD (IRE) well placed, was bumped and steadied approaching the eighth pole, then closed to gain the place. ELLENICA (IRE) unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and finished willingly for the show. BEAUTY SWEEP well placed, lacked the needed late response. DYNA TWO allowed to settle, saved ground and improved her position. CHATTER PATTERN wearing a nasal strip, moved up to stalk the pace after breaking slowly, inherited a slim lead when NEVADA LIGHTS ducked through the rail, then gave way in the final sixteenth. DYNA MIGHT wearing a nasal strip, failed to menace. SILVER BANDANA wearing a nasal strip, raced in striking position three wide, then bumped with CIRCLE OF GOLD approaching the eighth pole and tired. GAMBLING THYME chased the pace along the rail, then was bumped and taken up when NEVADA LIGHTS ducked through the rail and failed to recover. NEVADA LIGHTS set the pace along the inside, then bumped GAMBLING THYME when she ducked through the rail and left the course nearing the eighth pole.
