**Footnotes**

PRIME QUEEN set the pace along the rail, shook off a challenge from TIGER BABE on the far turn and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to prevail. CHEROKEE PROMISE rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and rallied to be up for the place. NOTABLE CRAFT chased the pace along the inside, eased outside the leader for the stretch run and didn't do enough late. RIOTOUS MISS reserved early, angled to the inside for the stretch run and closed with a mild rally. YOU'LL BE HAPPY tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch and lacked a late response. LOJO allowed to settle, raced four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. MY DANCIN GIRL steadied in the early going, saved ground and was not a factor. FESTIVE MADAM was outrun. LA CAT showed little. TIGER BABE chased the pace to nearing the stretch and faltered.
