Footnotes

WINSTON C stalked the pace along the inside, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied to be up in the final strides. DIDN'T TAKE IT set the pace along the rail to deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner while clearly best of the others. STARSHIP STORM chased the pace into the stretch and gave way. MALIBU WAVE unhurried after being steadied in the early going, passed tired rivals. PUREST FORM well placed into the far turn, tired. BERNIE BY THREE was not a factor. POWERFUL INSTINCT steadied along the inside leaving the first turn, saved ground into the far turn and faltered. LANDS N TRADITIONS chased the pace along the inside into the far turn and faded. CALM EXPRESSIONS off slowly, was outrun while racing four wide. JONATHAN C broke slowly, raced three wide and was through after a half mile. BIG HEAT was done early. FASHION LEADER tracked the leaders three wide to the far turn, then stopped.
