HEIR TO DARE pressed the pace outside ANGEL'S GLORY, took over from that rival approaching the eighth pole, then drew clear under urging. MINESTRONE chased the pace off the rail into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while proving best of the rest. CHANCE BUY tracked the leaders three wide around the turn, then couldn't keep pace with the top one while gaining the show. ANGEL'S GLORY stumbled at the start, set the pace under pressure along the inside into the stretch, then tired. FOREVER CANDY off slowly, failed to menace. PASSIONATE GOLD stumbled at the start and was not a factor. FATHOM rated off the pace, faltered leaving the turn. GIFT LIST was done early.
