Footnotes

PERFECT TRIPPI broke inward at start, rushed up and took command, set the pace along the inside in the backstretch, was challenged by DANGEROUS TRICK nearing the far turn, held off rival and pulled away in stretch. DANGEROUS TRICK broke sharp and settled in behind the leader in opening stages, continued to track the pace in the backstretch, began to edge up to leader entering the far turn, drifted out six wide, lost ground, shifted back in under right handed urging and secure place position. RIMAL AL SAHARA tracked the pace along the inside in the backstretch, asked to pick up the pace nearing the far turn, raced two off the inside in the far turn and lacked late kick to make an impact. LEAVE IT TO BERN was allowed to settle in early stages and stalked the pace along the outside of a rival, saved ground along the rail in the far turn and improved position in the stretch. RIVERSTAR settled and stalked the

pace in early stages, was carried out by rival in the far turn and continued a mild bid in the stretch. BLUE BUSINESS was unhurried in opening stages, urged to pick up pace going into the turn, carried out seven wide into the far turn and failed to be a threat in the stretch. STARSHIP ROMEO stalked between rivals in early stages, raced within contention leaving the backstretch, drifted out in the far turn and weakened in the drive. OMEGA RISING was brushed by rival at the start, raced near the back of rivals, continued reserved nearing the far turn and passed tiring rivals in the drive. SARAVA STAR stalked between rivals in early stages, asked for response leaving the backstretch and failed to response. KAMINSKI settled along the rail in the backstretch and failed to make a bid. BEA TOP QUALITY tracked the pace in early stages, urged along leaving the backstretch, was carried out five wide in the far turn and came up empty in the stretch. MYLILMANWIL trailed throughout and was eased up in the stretch.
