NO DEADLINE outran RIZZI GIRL for the lead, opened a clear lead racing along the rail and held on well while being edged to the wire. BOWL OF EMERALDS outran early, raced three wide around the far turn and closed to be up for the show. MISS BO BLUSH reserved early, advanced three wide on the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch and flattened out. MISS MARY (ARG) tired from good position. MICHAEL'S QUEEN was no factor after being outran early. MOM'S APPEAL failed to menace. RIZZI GIRL chased the pace along the inside and faltered. ARDENT LOVER saved ground and faded. CEILING was through early.
