THE A. TRAIN chased the pace along the inside, moved to take over midway of the turn, then drew clear through the stretch under urging. ORALE VATO chased the pace three wide, made a run at the winner nearing the quarter pole but couldn't stay with that rival while clearly second best. HUGO LIGHT showed speed off the rail to midway of the turn, then gave way. WIRE CUTTER broke awkwardly, tracked the pace along the inside to midway of the turn, angled out and tired. FRANKLINPARK failed to menace. FOLLOW THE LEAD tracked the leaders three wide to nearing the stretch, then faltered. GREAT BEAR was not a factor. SHANDAR was outrun. SAMURAI SWORD chased the leaders four wide into the turn, then had nothing left. CERTAIN APPEAL rated off the pace, faded in the drive. PROUD TRAIL was done early.
