Footnotes

IMPERIAL STRIKE stalked the pace along the inside, came around STARSHIP HOLLYWOOD leaving the far turn, then rallied inside MOREDIAMONDSPLEASE to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole and drew clear. NUBE DE AGUA unhurried early, rallied three wide around the far turn

to reach near even terms for command racing into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. RARO rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and closed to gain the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. DELTA LADY outrun after breaking slowly, saved ground and passed tired rivals. MOREDIAMONDSPLEASE reserved after being caught in tight early, rallied to gain a slim lead on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then tired. SHEERFLAKESOFGOLD failed to menace. AINSLEY allowed to settle, was caught in traffic on the far turn and never threatened. PHOEBE MOON was outrun. STARSHIP HOLLYWOOD outran EDISTO LADY for the lead around the first turn, made the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn, then faltered. MY SATURDAY GIRL was no factor after being steadied in the early going. EDISTO LADY showed speed along the inside around the first turn, eased out to chase STARSHIP HOLLYWOOD into the far turn after losing the lead to that rival, then had nothing left. GREEN TEA ICECREAM chased the pace for a half mile and faded.
