CIRCULARITY pulled in opening stages, settled in slightly along the rail and tracked the pace, asked to make a bid for leader leaving the backstretch, quickly picked up the pace along the rail, edged up to the lead, took command at the top of the lane and continued clear. LIZARD'S REPENT rushed up to take the lead out of the gate, continued to set the pace along the rail by a secure margin in the backstretch, challenged by CIRCULARITY heading for home, lost the lead and dug back in for second late strides. R PAYNES PRINCE tracked the pace along the rail in the backstretch, asked for response nearing the far turn, gained ground between rivals and continued a steady bid in the stretch. PORTMAN raced five wide into the first turn, stalked three to four off the inside in the backstretch, floated out six wide in the final turn and lacked final kick to make a serious impact in the drive. TOTEMTALE was unhurried in early stages settled in near the back, asked for response leaving the backstretch, quickly gained ground, raced between rivals heading into the far turn and failed to sustain bid in the late drive. BAD NEWS CAPTAIN was settled back near the back in opening stages, continued reserved leaving the backstretch and gained ground to improve position in the stretch. ERUPTION ZONE raced behind the leader in early stages, raced between rivals leaving the backstretch and began to weaken at the top of the lane. CURRENT RUCKUS tracked the pace in early stages, raced between rivals heading into the far turn and came

up empty in the stretch. RACHEL'S GIRL raced five wide into the first turn, settled in near the back of rivals in the backstretch and failed to rally in the stretch. HIGHSPEEDINTERNET pulled along the rail in early stages, settled in near the back along the inside and lacked response in the drive. IGOTCHANOW stalked the pace between rivals in early stages, began to falter after a half mile and was eased up in the stretch.
