FINALE allowed to settle in early stages and stalk the pace, asked to pick up the pace leaving the backstretch, swung out three wide in the far turn, edged up along the outside of rivals midstretch and edged by final sixteenth pole. LIVINGSTON STREET tracked the top two leaders in early stages, made a bid nearing the turn and edged up to the lead, vied into the lane with BEAR'S TIZZ and could not match strides in the final sixteenth. BINGO BANGO BONGO

stalked the pace along the inside in the backstretch, asked to pick up the pace nearing the far turn, gained position under right handed encouragement and was up for show. BEAR'S TIZZ took command away from the gate, continued to dictate the pace in the backstretch, challenged by rivals heading into far turn, vied with LIVINGSTON STREET into the lane and could not keep up the pace in the late drive. LIGHTHOUSE SOUND was allowed to settle in early stages, asked for response leaving the backstretch and improved position in the stretch. MINISTER COLIN was well reserved in opening stages racing in the back of rivals, raced in just a bit tight in the backstretch, steadied sharply, briefly lost momentum, swung out wide in the far turn, gained position in the stretch but was too late to make an impact. SAFETY ZONE lacked speed in early stages and raced in or near the back of the pack, angled out slightly in the far turn and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. HOLY SMOKE stalked the front runners in the backstretch, slightly weakened after a half mile and lacked response in the drive. MUSICAL FLAIR stalked the pace in the early going, began to lose position heading into the far turn and had nothing left in the stretch. MR. ONLINE was reserved in early stages, made a bid heading into the far turn and began to falter entering the top of the stretch. ROCK ALEX raced just off the leader in early stages, began to tire after a half mile and continued to falter. TIMELESS FASHION tracked the pace in early stages and had nothing left after a half mile.
