Footnotes

FLY FOR AVIE raced far back for six furlongs, rapidly gained on the turn, circled six wide into the stretch and unleashed a strong late run in the middle of the track to win going away. OPEN LINE raced just off the pace between horses to the turn then finished willingly to gain the place. MERCURY DIRECT forced the pace from outside into midstretch and held for a share. GOLDEN FORTUNE set the pace under pressure along the inside into upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. CANADIAN FLAGSHIP went evenly while saving ground. ALEGRARE was unhurried for six furlongs, gained a bid while four wide on the turn then lacked a strong closing response. CORPORATE MISS raced up close from outside to the turn, then checked in traffic in upper stretch. NOBLE SWORD failed to mount a serious rally. PENTAGRAMA raced wide wide to the turn and tired. MISS VIC was outrun after being pinched at the start.
