GAL O GAL reserved while saving ground, eased outside ROYAL DOVE at the top of the stretch, rallied to catch that rival inside the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. LIL SCOUT steadied in the early going, raced four wide on the far turn and rallied to gain the place. TWO SHARKY BETTY rated off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and closed to be up for the show. ROYAL DOVE vied for the lead along the rail, continued to make the pace to inside the eighth pole and gave way. OUTTA THE PARK outrun early, advanced along the rail to loom a threat in midstretch, then flattened out. COMEBACK TO ME reserved off the pace, lacked a late response. THEMUS unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and failed to threaten. POCKET WISH chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and faltered. SPECIALITY vied for the lead outside ROYAL DOVE to nearing the stretch and faded. PROUD AMERICAN was through early.
