Footnotes

HIGH BRASS rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, rallied to catch HARBOR RIDGE at the sixteenth pole and edged away. HARBOR RIDGE chased the pace, rallied along the inside to take over at the eighth pole but couldn't stay with the winner in the final sixteenth. NADER unhurried after breaking poorly, passed tired rivals for the show. MASTERWORK showed speed three wide, was outmoved by GRANDE down the backstretch, made a run to regain the lead from that rival on the turn, maintained a slim advantage to nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. GRANDE bobbled at the start, moved up quickly to show speed along the rail, edged away from MASTERWORK racing down the backstretch, lost the lead on the turn, then was starting to tire when checked from tight quarters at the top of the stretch. FABULOUS TEXAS failed to menace. MASHARKA showed early foot, raced three wide around the turn and faltered. A QUESTION OF TIME was through after a half mile. The rider of GRANDE lodged an objection against the rider of HARBOR RIDGE for alleged interference at the top of the stretch. The claim of foul was not allowed.
