Footnotes

BRADY MIESTER rated off the pace, was moving up smartly when steadied along to avoid running up on rivals from midway of the turn to the top of the stretch, split rivals to gain the lead and drew away while in hand. GIVEMETHIRTYDAYS allowed to settle, circled rivals five wide to reach the attending position but couldn't match strides with the winner while proving best of the rest. MILWAUKEE WOLF reserved early, was checked when trapped in behind

rivals nearing the stretch, then checked again when unable to get through along the inside at the eighth pole, recovered and closed to be up for the show. SWEETNDANDY outrun early, passed tired rivals in the drive. TRICK ACT vied for the lead between horses to the top of the stretch, then gave way. AMARILLO SKY well placed early, steadied to avoid the broken down horse on the backstretch, made a run four wide to reach near even terms for command at the quarter pole, then tired. LISTOWEL BOY raced in striking position while saving ground, was steadied in behind NICHOLAS VISION leaving the turn and faltered. NICHOLAS VISION bumped with MARTY'S WILDCAT at the start, vied for the lead along the rail to the top of the stretch, then had nothing left. LOUDERTHANTHUNDER was not a factor. ROMAN SUR vied for the lead three wide to nearing the quarter pole, then faded. FULL HORSE POWER bumped with MARTY'S WILDCAT at the start, then steadied to avoid that same rival on the backstretch and was done early. MARTY'S WILDCAT bumped between rivals at the start, was racing with the pace when he broke down on the backstretch and was pulled up.
