OUR DARK KNIGHT stalked the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the top of the stretch and opened a clear lead, then was all out to hold RON THE GREEK safe. The latter, outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and rallied to prove second best. HEADACHE rated off the pace after bumping with EL KINGDOM and being steadied in the early going, passed tired rivals for the show. BERNIE THE MAESTRO chased the pace along the inside around the turn and gave way. PRIMARY WITNESS failed to menace after bumping with EL KINGDOM and being steadied in the early going. IMPERIAL COUNCIL was not a factor. EL KINGDOM reserved off the pace after being bumped and steadied from between rivals in the early going, tired in the drive. HEAR YE HEAR YE showed speed along the rail, vied with SUMO around the turn, then faltered. SUMO chased the pace, moved up to vie with HEAR YE HEAR YE around the turn, then faded.
