LATE CARSON was eased back just off the early leaders and moved to the outside, made a run to challenge from outside on the turn then wore down DEPUTY MAC under brisk urging. DEPUTY MAC dueled early from outside, opened a clear advantage midway on the turn then battled gamely along the inside into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. HERE'S FIVE raced well back to the turn, then passed only tiring horses. PISTOL STAR dueled early along the inside and gave way leaving the turn. VALID TREFAIRE failed to mount a serious rally. STROLL ON checked after bobbling at the start, raced three wide to the turn and tired.
