FISHERMAN'S WHARF rated off the pace, steadied entering the first turn, eased out leaving the far turn, then rallied and split rivals in deep stretch to be up in the final strides. KIM'S DIXIE TUNE unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied along the outside to be up for the place. B B'S CONCORDE allowed to settle, rallied four wide to reach even terms for command with YAROSLAV on the far turn, then duelled with that rival to deep stretch and was outfinished. YAROSLAV chased the pace, made a run to reach even terms for command with B B'S CONCORDE, then duelled with that one to

deep stretch and yielded. PEACEFUL RUSSIAN reserved early, saved ground and finished willingly. READY SET RULE stalked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and weakened. PAISANO CREEK well placed for a half mile, made a run three wide to join the leaders on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. HABITUAL was racing in striking position when steadied on the far turn and failed to recover. STORM MANDATE was not a factor. LUVANDGO stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. SUN SCORPION set the pace along the rail into the far turn, then had nothing left. KING MIDAS chased the pace three wide to the far turn, then faltered.
