Footnotes

HISTORY AHEAD reserved racing along the rail into the stretch, angled to the outside for racing room, rallied to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole,

then drew clear. FURIOUS RUN stalked the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn, made the pace to inside the eighth pole but couldn't match strides with the winner late. WORRIED MAN rated off the pace, angled out in the stretch and finished willingly to be up for the show. EVENFOREVER well placed, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then flattened out and finished on even terms with SARAH'S TIGER. The latter, stalked the pace into the stretch, then weakened and dead heated with EVENFOREVER. ASKARI set the pace along the rail, responded when headed by FURIOUS RUN entering the stretch, then gave way in the final eighth. BLACK OPS HONOR rank in the early going, pressed the pace outside ASKARI, moved up to reach even terms for command on the far turn, contested the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then tired. TESTED tracked the pace along the inside, then was steadied in behind rivals approaching the sixteenth pole and failed to recover. O'SHEA was not a factor. CONSULATE was outrun. HOWARD'S EDGE was done early and eased leaving the far turn.
