**Footnotes**

DATA LINK unhurried early, saved ground around the far turn, came around TERMINAL ONE in early stretch, rallied to engage BEACHCOMBING at the eighth pole, then dueled with that rival and prevailed. BEACHCOMBING stalked the pace, rallied three wide to take over soon after entering the stretch, responded when challenged by DATA LINK at the eighth pole, then dueled with that rival and was edged to the wire. PLAINVIEW rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals to be up for the show. OLD MASTER EXPERT (GB) allowed to settle, swung wide for the stretch run and improved his position. DR. TOM G checked from between rivals soon after the start, saved ground into the stretch, eased out and failed to menace. AND I LIKE IT TOO saved ground and never threatened. GOSPEL LESSON reserved off the pace, steadied in traffic on the far turn, swung out and made a run to loom a threat entering the stretch, then gave way. TERMINAL ONE quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the rail into the stretch, then tired. HALO DOCTOR JOE steadied to avoid running up on TERMINAL ONE racing into the first turn, moved up on the backstretch to press the pace outside that rival to the top of the stretch, then faltered. BLUEGRASS JET stalked the pace four wide to nearing the stretch and faded.
