### Footnotes

CAIRO SIX bumped with IL VOLO after the start, stalked the pace saving ground, took over late stretch and edged clear under pressure. IL VOLO bumped with CAIRO SIX and knocked sideways after the start, was allowed to settle then rallied belatedly to be up for the place. DEFIANT rank early, pressed the pace off the rail, took over on the final turn, set the pace into late stretch and gave way. AYRTON tracked the speed between horses and finished evenly. TIMARK well placed off the rail, rallied mildly. PHINEUS (ARG) unhurried early, rallied belatedly. ROARS MORE slow early, rallied mildly. CASH YOUR TICKET chased the speed four wide and weakened. SOLICITATION set the pace saving ground into the final turn and faded. MAD PATRIOT was outrun.
