DE BERTIE outrun after breaking slowly, advanced five wide around the far turn, rallied to take over just inside the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. ROYAL FAIR unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied to be up for the place. FRANKLY MY DEAR pressed the pace outside CASTLEBROOK, moved to take over on the far turn and gave way grudgingly in the drive. CASH'S PRIDE unhurried early, raced in traffic on the far turn and improved her position without threatening. MY ONLY DESIRE chased the pace three wide into the far turn, then tired in the drive. CASTLEBROOK made the pace along the inside into the far turn and gave way. GOLD FOR MY GAL faltered racing along the rail. SCRATCH PAD steadied entering the first turn, chased the pace for a half mile and faded.
