Footnotes

CROSS TRAFFIC raced just behind the leader in opening stages, edged up to WICKERSHEIM leaving the backstretch, dueled with rival along the outside, continued to battle for lead into stretch, took command at the sixteenth pole and continued clear. WICKERSHEIM took command in opening stages, continued to set the pace along the inside, challenged by CROSS TRAFFIC nearing the far turn, battled for the lead along the rail into the stretch and could not match strides at the sixteenth pole. SUCCESSFUL RUNNER stalked the pace along the rail in the backstretch, made a bid for the top two leaders heading into the far turn, raced three wide into the lane, drifted out slightly, angled back in and continued a steady bid to the wire. MACHO SPACES tracked the top two leaders in opening stages, saved ground racing along the rail, urged to pick up the pace going into the turn and lacked a kick to make an impact in the drive. COMMON BOND saved ground racing along the rail into the lane and failed to rally in the stretch. CHILEAN BOY floated out five wide in the far turn and lacked response in the drive.
